Date	Location	Directions
18 May	Telegraph Station	Our opening event – meet at the river bank just behind the Telegraph Station building. We'll have a BBQ afterwards so bring some food and drink. Friends and families welcome. No alcohol restrictions.
15 June	Emily Gap	Coming from town take the Ross River Hwy for 11.4 km. Emily Gap on the left. Meet near car park.
20 July	Venue To be advised.	
17 Aug.	Temple Bar	Meet at left turn onto road to Archery Complex 7.8km along Ilparpa Rd. T.O. immediately before right turn into Clay Pans when coming from town.
21 Sept.	Simpsons Gap/ Cassia Hill	Check Cassia Hill car park first or proceed to Simpsons car park. We will be in the river below the car park.

What you may wish to bring:

Sun screen and hat; insect repellent?; jacket if it's cold; Something to sit on (small cushion, fold up chair etc.); Water and/or a flask of tea or coffee; A bag for your rubbish; A camera in case you want to record a scene; art materials (you shouldn't have to walk far, however we suggest keeping your materials to a minimum).
